Treasurer's Report

The Annual [Statement of Account](#), [Budget](#) and [Treasurer's Report](#) were on the website and issued with the Agenda.

The Accounts have been examined by Donald S Mackenzie CA.

The Treasurer had changed the date for closing the books to end December, so accounts were for 10 months, showing a closing balance of £7762 but with some expenses and a significant reimbursement still to come. There was a small operating deficit of £204.

The Treasurer recommended that the subscriptions remain unchanged at £50.

Motor Sports Council 2019
