Autotest co-ordinator report

Hi there

I have been very busy lately and have not had a lot of time to formalise the details of a S.A.M.C, Autotest Championship yet.

A request was sent out from our chairman asking clubs who organize Autotests to get in touch with me giving a brief report on their seasons Autotests/PCAs, to date I have received **4 Reports**.

From these reports, they show a varied picture –

South of Scotland – average entries of 22

Glenrothes MSC – average entries of 12-14

750 MC – average entries of 8-9

North East Group – average entries of 8-10

To allow me to decide whether it would be worth running a SAMSC Autotest Championship I need more information from the other clubs in Scotland who run these type of events to establish the viability of a Championship and also how well it would be supported.

The draft proposals for the Championships are.

To avoid too much travelling entrants would be encouraged to support their local events and avoid date clashes with similar events to increase the entries.

Each competitor would use **5** events to count for points in the Championship, their best results in **4** local or regional events plus their best results from the Championship Final, held in October/ November.

The more proactive the clubs are, the greater chance we could resurrect the championship.
