Dear Ms Campbell

I write to you as chairman of the Scottish Association of Car Clubs (SACC). SACC represents over 50 local clubs from around Scotland that organise motorsport events. At the end of 2017, these clubs had a combined membership of over 6,400.

The governing body for motorsport is the UK based Motor Sport Association (MSA) and there is no dedicated Scottish governing body for our sport. SACC is however an associate member of the Scottish Sports Association (SSA) and we very much value the services available through the SSA and are fully supportive of its aims and objectives.

I am led to understand that the Scottish Government and SportScotland have intimated that the current funding stream available to the SSA will not be continued beyond the current financial year.

I want to put on record my disappointment with this decision. The SSA provides an important service to the sport governing bodies in Scotland, especially the smaller bodies and those, like us, that are part of UK wide bodies.

Can I ask that as the Minister for Public Health and Sport, you urge the Scottish Government to reconsider the funding approach to the SSA and ensure the body can continue to support all of its members and associate members in the goals of promoting all aspects of involvement in sport

Dear Mr Weall Thank you for your letter dated 22 November 2017 to the Minister for Public Health and Sport, Ms Aileen Campbell MSP, regarding funding for the Scottish Sports Association. As part of the Active Scotland Division, I have been asked to reply. The Scottish Government has a strong relationship with the SSA and appreciates the support that it provides to Scottish sporting governing bodies. The SSA is a membership organisation for sporting governing bodies and we believe it is for their membership to ultimately determine how best to fund and support the SSA to effectively promote the views of the sector. We route funding to support our SGBs through sportscotland and do not provide core funding to the SSA. In financial year 2017-18, we provided funding for the SSA to carry out a short-term project that focused on assessing equalities issues within SGBs, as well as work to support the Government to identify grass-roots nominations for the honours process. With respect to the administrative support provided to SGBs by the SSA, we believe, with the context of a challenging financial backdrop, sportscotland are best placed to deliver that support and are committed to continuing to provide a significant amount of time, expertise, and investment to help Scottish Governing Bodies of sport (SGBs) deliver on their objectives.
